This is not compulsory. Plaques can be purchased separately, and any amount above this is given freely as a donation. For Gift Aid purposes, the amount of your payment which may be claimed is £9,500. Plaques will be displayed for a minimum of ten years, after which you will be contacted to find out if you wish to renew your contribution. Pillars are subject to availability and allocated by the School. The King's School reserves the right to approve and adjust the final message on your plaque.
